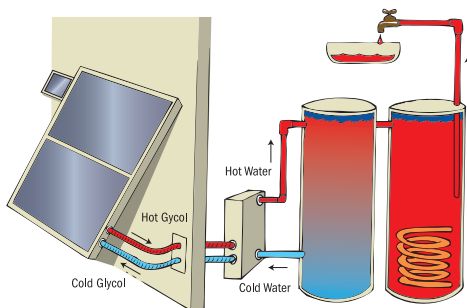

Typical Domestic Solar Hot Water System for a family of 4

Follow these Steps

1. Find an open sunny space on your property (roof/wall/ground) facing south.
2. Check that you have space for an additional hot water tank & heat exchanger.
3. Have your property assessed by a recognized solar hot water installer to see if your property is suitable for a solar hot water installation.
4. Get a quote from your recognized installer who uses CSA (Canadian Standards Association) approved products and is aware of the New Brunswick electrical and plumbing codes and regulations for solar hot water systems.
